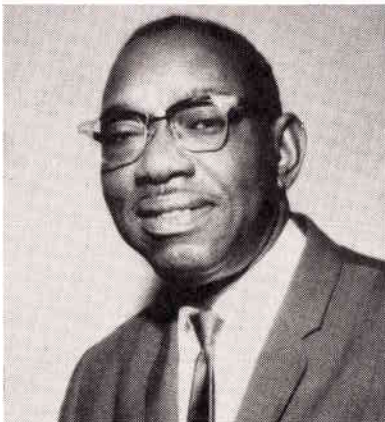




Dr. SANDY F. RAY: Graduate of Morehouse College, Atlanta, Georgia; Arkansas Baptist College, Little Rock, Arkansas (DD Degree in 1936); Graduate study, Chicago University. He served pastorates in La-Grange, Georgia; Macon, Georgia; Chicago, Illinois; Columbus, Ohio. He had a religious radio program each week for five years in Columbus, Ohio; served in Ohio Legislature; National Council for Christians and Jews; Committee, Department of Social Welfare, National Council of Churches of Christ of U.S.A.; Chairman, Social Action Committee—National Baptist Convention; Moderator, Eastern Baptist Association of Brooklyn and Long Island; Brooklyn Division of the Protestant Council; Kings County Council; State Commission Against Discrimination, and is the President of Empire State Baptist Missionary Convention, New York. He is now serving as pastor of the Cornerstone Baptist Church, Brooklyn, New York.



DR. DALE MOODY: Graduate of Baylor University, Waco, Texas, B.A.; Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky, Th.M., Th.D.; Oxford University, Ph.D.; served pastorates in Texas, Indiana, and Kentucky; taught 10 years Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, then elected, 1954, to the Joseph Emerson Brown Chair of Theology. He has been Fellow of the Society on Religion in Higher Education since 1944 and studied on the Society's Kent Fellowship in Columbia University; member of the Commission on the Church, Baptist World Alliance; Faith and Order Commission, World Council of Churches; served as Assistant to Paul Tillich in Systematic Theology in Union Theological Seminary in 1944-45. As a student at the University of Zurich, Switzerland, he lived with Emil Brunner; and at the University of Basel, Switzerland in 1948, he studied under Karl Barth. He had a Faculty Fellowship in University of Heidelberg, Germany, 1957-58, was visiting Fellow, Regent's Park College, Oxford University, 1961-63; has spoken and traveled in 26 countries and nations; Editor of Theological articles in *Encyclopedia of Southern Baptists*; Contributor to *Interpreter's Dictionary of the Bible*, the symposium on *What is the Church?*, and *The Theology of Emil Brunner* (Vol. III) *The Library of Living Theology*. Author of *Christ and The Church*, *The Hope of Glory*. Dr. Moody was a lecturer at the Ecumenical Institute in Bossey, Switzerland. The Swiss Theologian Emil Brunner has written of him: "I think I would not be in error if I call him the theologian best informed on my theological works."



REV. WILLIAM KENNARD RICHARDSON: Graduate of American Baptist Theological Seminary, B.Th. and A.B. degrees. He has held pastorates at the First Baptist Church in Scottsville, Kentucky, and the Saint Paul Baptist Church, Saint Albans, West Virginia. In 1965 he assumed the duties of the pastorate of Friendship Baptist Church, Warren, Ohio. He has served as member of the St. Albans Ministerial Association, Vice Chairman of the Mayor's Advisory Committee, executive board Federated Services of St. Albans, Inc., Executive committee N.A.A.C.P. (Charleston, W. Va. Branch), Secretary of the Minister's Conference of W. Va. Baptist State Convention. He is a veteran of World War II.
