


DR. D. C. WASHINGTON. A.B., B.D., D.D., Executive Director, National Baptist Sunday School Publishing Board of the National Baptist Convention, U.S.A., Inc., Nashville, Tennessee; former pastor, Seventeenth Street Baptist Church, Huntsville, Alabama, and other churches in Alabama; Trustee of American Baptist Theological Seminary.

DR. EDWIN D. IOHNSTON, A.B., Th.M., Ph.D., Th.D., Roberts Professor of Bible, Mercer University, Macon, Georgia. He has earned degrees from Mercer University, Southern Baptist Theological Seminary and the University of Manchester, England, and has done further study at Union Theological Seminary, N. Y.; teaching experience includes New Testament, Old Testament, Greek, Church History; nonacademic experience in pastorates and U.S. Army Chaplaincy; learned and professional societies include American Association of University Professors, Society of Biblical Literature and Exegesis (Vice-President, Southern Section), Association of Baptist Professors of Religion, Reserve Officers Association. He has given numerous important lectures and addresses and has written a number of Nationally recognized articles and papers.



DR. T. E. HUNTLEY, A.B., B.D., D.D., Central Baptist Church, St. Louis, Missouri, outstanding pulpiteer, well known author, founder of the Church on Wheels (taking the gospel message to many who do not ordinarily attend church), chief editor of the foreign (English) publications of the Bharath Social and Cultural Trust of South India, national leader in Christian life and religious education, Trustee of American Baptist Theological Seminary.

DR. MELVIN H. WATSON, A.B., M.A., B.D., S.T.M., Th.D., Associate Professor of Theology at the Interdenominational Theological Center, Atlanta, Georgia. He has earned degrees from Morehouse College, Oberlin College and Graduate School of Theology, and Pacific School of Religion, and has done further study at University of Chicago and at Union Theological Seminary, N. Y.; has served as Dean of Men and Director of Religious Life at Shaw and Dillard Universities; Acting Dean of the Chapel of Howard University, and for ten years Director of the Morehouse School of Religion. He is pastor of Liberty Baptist Church, Atlanta.
