Pastor William Varnell Green is a native of Cleveland, Ohio, and was reared by his mother in a single parent household. He has served as the Pastor of The Tabernacle of Glory Baptist Church since January 1, 2007.

Pastor Green was introduced to The Tabernacle of Glory in

1981, when he was a student at American Baptist College in Nashville, Tennessee. While at The Tabernacle of Glory (then known as Pilgrim Emmanuel Baptist Church), he served as an Associate Minister and played an active role in the development of biblical studies.

Upon graduating from American Baptist College with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1985, Pastor Green returned to Cleveland, Ohio, where he taught in the Cuyahoga County public school system. In 1987, he was called to pastor The Galilee Baptist Church of Barberton, Ohio. During the same year, he married Faye Yvette Stevens, whom he met while attending Pilgrim Emmanuel Baptist Church in Nashville.

Pastor Green served the Galilee family faithfully for 20 years and is known locally, throughout the state and the country for his love of God, passion for people, and applied Christianity. Through his example, teaching and preaching, many lives have been changed and enhanced by coming to know God.

Pastor Green serves the community as a pastor and teacher, life coach, motivational speaker, and spiritual advisor. God has led him to use his personal background, education, and experiences to create a ministry that builds relationships by combining tenets of Christianity, business and the 12-Step recovery program in non-traditional ways.

Pastor Green earned a Master's of Arts in Christian Ministries from Malone University in Canton, Ohio, in 2002. In July 2012, Pastor Green participated in the prestigious Seabury-Kellogg Summer Institute, a program jointly sponsored by the Seabury-Western Theological Seminary and Kellogg School of Management at Northwestern University. He is currently pursuing a certificate in non-profit management offered by the Kellogg Center for Non-profit Management. William and Faye have two biological children, Rev. William Varnell, II and Lydia Lenise, and many other children that God has added to their family.
