He received his Bachelor of Arts degree at Fisk University, and was awarded the Degree of Bachelor of Divinity at the Chicago Theological Seminary, University of Chicago. Too, he has pursued further study at Union Theological Seminary in New York City and Princeton Theological Seminary.

Rev. Harvey was Pastor of Pinn Memorial Baptist Church, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania for ten and one-half years. He served at Calvary Baptist Church in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma for four years. For the past four years he has pastored of the Macedonia Baptist Church, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

CLYDE T. FRANCISCO was born in Virgilina, Virginia, June 2, 1916. He received his A.B. Degree at the University of Richmond (Highest average in history of the school—all A's, 3.00), his Th.M. Degree at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, and his Th.D. Degree at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. Too, he has pursued further study at the University of California and Stanford University Pacific School of Religion.

Rev. Francisco was Pastor of Gwathmey Baptist Church, Ashland, Virginia; Pastor of Bedfore Baptist Church, Bedfore, Kentucky; Interim Pastor of Immanuel Baptist Church, Lexington, Kentucky; Interim Pastor of First Baptist Church, Bowling Green, Kentucky; Interim Pastor of First Baptist Church, Kenora, West Virginia; Interim Pastor of Central Baptist Church, Lexington, Kentucky; and Visiting Professor at Golden Gate Seminary, 1953-54.

Rev. Francisco currently serves as John R. Sampey Professor of Old Testament Interpretation, Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky. He is a member of Phi Beta Kappa, Sigma Alpha Epsilon, Society of Biblical Literature and Exegesis, The National Association of Biblical Instructors. He is author of

HENLEE HULIX BARNETTE was born August 14, 1911. He received his B.A. Degree at Wake Forest College, Wake Forest, North Carolina, 1940; his Th.M. Degree at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky, 1943; and his Th.D. Degree at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Kentucky, 1948. Too, he has pursued further study at Columbia University and Union Seminary, New York.

Rev. Barnette was ordained to the ministry July 10, 1935. He has served as Pastor of First Baptist Church, Landis, North Carolina; Pastor of West Point Baptist Church, Kannapolis, North Carolina; Pastor of Corinth and New Sandy Creek Baptist Churches in North Carolina; Pastor and Superintendent of Central Baptist Mission, Haymarket District, Louisville, Kentucky, 1942-46; Assistant Professor of Sociology, Howard College, Birmingham, Alabama, 1946-47; and Professor of Religion and Sociology, John B. Stetson University, De Land, Florida, 1947-51.

Rev. Barnette currently serves as Acting Dean of the School of Theology and Associate Professor of Christian Ethics. He is a member of the Christian Life Commission of the Southern Baptist Convention, Pi Gamma Mu (Social Science Fraternity), Omicron Delta Kappa (National Leadership Fraternity), American Sociological Society and the American Association for the Advancement of Science. His travels includes Europe and Russia.

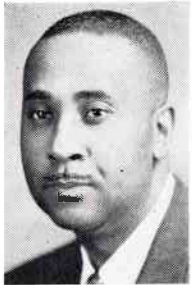
