# Rev. Davie Tucker

Beech Creek Baptist Church Sunday, May 10, 2009 11:00 a.m.

Reverend Tucker was born and raised in Nashville, Tennessee and educated in the public school system. He accepted the call into the ministry at Beech Creek Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of Reverend Grant Watkins Jr. He was ordained in July of 2002 and was subsequently selected and confirmed to serve as the Assistant Pastor at Beech Creek in September of 2002. In January of 2007 he was elected to serve as Pastor.

Reverend Tucker attended Volunteer State College in Gallatin, Tennessee majoring in accounting. He graduated from American Baptist College in Nashville, Tennessee with an A.A. in Pastoral Studies and a B.A. in Biblical Studies. During his matriculation at American Baptist College he served as President of the Student Government Association. In addition, Rev. Tucker completed the Executive Leadership Development Program at Harvard University in Cambridge Massachusetts.

His work experience includes a nine-year stint in the United States Marine Corps, Jail Administrator for the Davidson County Sheriff's Department and most recently, Vice President of Operations and Chief Operating Officer for TransCor America, Inc. Rev. Tucker is a member of the Interdenominational Ministers Fellowship and the Vice-President of the Nashville Baptist Ministers Conference.

He is married to the former Ms. Carla Williams; they are raising two boys: Jarrod and Michael, twelve and twenty-two years old, respectively.

## Rev. James Thomas

Baptist World Center Sunday, May 10, 2009 5:00 p.m.

In Orange, Texas, on February 26, 1940, Reverend Thomas and his twin brother, Jerry, became the fourth and fifth of thirteen children born to the late Mr. and Mrs. Edgar Thomas. The family later moved to Beaumont, Texas, where Reverend Thomas attended local public schools until graduating from Charlton Pollard High School in 1959.

It was in 1950, under the spiritual leadership of the late Reverend Dr. U. S. Keeling, Sr., that Reverend Thomas was converted and joined Mount Zion Baptist Church, of Beaumont, Texas; but it was under the pastorate of the late Reverend J. H. Wright, Pastor of Booker Baptist Church in Beaumont, Texas, that the call to the ministry was accepted.

In 1971, Reverend Thomas was united in holy matrimony to the former Ida Phillips of Murfreesboro, Tennessee. On June 20, 1971, he became the eighth pastor of the Jefferson Street Missionary Baptist Church. Because of his leadership, Jefferson Street has become a shining symbol of the grace of God in the greater Nashville, Tennessee community. This church is known both nationally and internationally for its innovative approach to Christian leadership. Jefferson Street has been visited by both secular and non-secular organizations from virtually every ethnic group in this country; it has been visited twice by members of the Social Democratic Party of Germany.

During the past 30 years, Reverend Thomas' interest in the welfare of the entire community has led him into various areas of evangelic and civic work. His relentless and untiring efforts have greatly benefitted the broader community, and his work has been invaluable to the African-American diaspora. For five years, he served as a member of the Foreign Mission Board of the National Baptist Convention of America, Inc. He also served ten years as Co-chair of the Davidson County Rainbow Coalition, having been a founding organizer. Furthermore, he served twelve years as president of the Missionary Baptist State Convention of Tennessee, and he served ten years as Moderator of the Convention's Nashville City District Association.

Reverend Thomas holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Bible Theology with a minor in Pastoral Studies from American Baptist College. He has also completed course work toward a Master's Degree in Theology at Vanderbilt University, Nashville, Tennessee.
